Joined by singers from the community, the St. Bartholomew Choir will perform the first part Handel's monumental oratorio *Messiah*. Also joining in the performance will be guest "rising star" soloists from the Peabody Conservatory.

Handel's *Messiah* needs little introduction. It has been a staple of the choral repertoire since the 1750s, when annual charity performances at London's Foundling Hospital were led by Handel himself.

No admission will be charged for the concert. Events like this depend on the generosity of supporters from the parish and community.
