**September COVID Update:** The COVID transmission is coming down slowly in Baltimore County (moderate), but remains high in Baltimore City and Howard County (substantial). We may have passed the peak of this summer surge. The KP3.1.1 variant is becoming more prevalent around the country. The new Moderna and Pfizer vaccines are due to be released in a few weeks. The Novavax vaccine is also ready, and more effective against the current variants, but not approved yet. These are not boosters, but newly formulated vaccines for the more recent variants.

**Faith Forum returns in October.** Many changes are happening at St. B's this fall and Faith Forum will be making a small change as well and will be starting in October. This will give our new rector a chance to catch his breath (hopefully!) and see how he would like to be involved with this aspect of Adult Formation.
